## OHIO FFA GREENHAND CAMP

## September 26-28, 2021



Join other freshman FFA members who are participating in their first year of Agricultural Education from all over Ohio for three days at Ohio FFA Greenhand Camp that you will not want to miss. This three-day camp emphasizes team building, goal setting, introductory FFA, and plenty of recreational opportunities. Activities include dances, athletics, ranges, environmental activities, leadership workshops, meeting state officers, sports and much more. Greenhand Camp is held at Ohio FFA Camp Muskingum which is located in Carroll County, on the banks of Leesville Lake, has been offering unique outdoor experiences since 1942. The lake, hillside and forests offer prime opportunities for aquatic and nature studies.

The cost to attend camp is \$100.00. Cost can be made in payments but the whole cost must be paid in full BEFORE the trip. Checks should be made out to "Bradford FFA". To sign-up, you must turn in at least \$35.00 and complete this form with the proper signatures and Mr. Baumer will then register you for camp if you are selected to attend. Once you pay your first \$35.00 and are selected to attend, Mr. Baumer will register you for camp. The deadline to submit an application is Thursday, September 2 at 3:10 PM. There are only 8 spots for this trip. FFA camp has a \$35.00 no show fee. So therefore, if you do not show up for camp, \$35.00 of your original money cannot and will not be returned since the chapter will still be assessed that cost. If money is an issue, please talk to Mr. Baumer so something can be worked out to hopefully allow you to attend. We do not want you to miss out on this great opportunity because of a financial situation that exist.

## **Rules and Expectations**

- Eat and sleep.
- Stay in your own dorm and be only where you are supposed to be as directed by camp staff and FFA advisors.
- Cellphone use at any time during camp (with the exception of taking pictures) is not allowed. Interact with others, meet new people and get the full experience from camp.
- Bags or suitcases on trips can be checked by the advisor if there is suspicion that it may contain inappropriate materials or objects.
- No PDA
- School appropriate clothing should be worn only.
- Shirts and pants must be worn at all times. Simply wearing a long shirt is not acceptable.
- Represent the Bradford FFA Chapter with pride.
- Be on time.
- Follow all camp and school rules.
- Follow all guidelines and expectations of all FFA advisors and camp staff on the trip regardless of the chapter.
- Follow all COVID guidelines and do so without complaining or arguing. We are here to have a great trip with great people. Take an attitude of being grateful we are able to travel again, rather than complain about the few things we have been asked to do.
- Have fun and keep a positive attitude. (no complaining or grumpy people...BE HAPPY)

The following COVID protocols will be in place at camp this summer:

- All students and advisors will be required to fill out and bring to camp a COVID Waiver Form. (will be given to you after you register along with other paperwork)
- Students and advisors will need to bring masks to camp to wear when we are either inside or when we are unable to social distance. Masks will be available to purchase at the camp store with the camp logo on it.
- The beds in the dorms have been arranged to adequately social distance.
- A separate location on camp has been established to use as a quarantine location in case anyone shows symptoms of COVID.

- Upon arrival at camp, each person's temperature will be taken and if anyone has an elevated temperature they will be expected to return home along with anyone that they have traveled with. Temperatures will be taken at the school prior to leaving for camp.
- The camp recommends that if you have a compromised immune system, that you seek a recommendation from your doctor before registering for camp. If you have questions, please let Mr. Baumer know and he will provide you with Camp's phone number to contact them with questions.
- Each day of camp, random students will be selected for temperature checks.
- Precautions will be taken in the dining hall to effectively social distance by limiting seating at each table and utilize the upper porch and Assembly Hall if needed.
- Students will be encouraged to wash hands regularly.
- All Ohio Department of Health orders will continue to be followed.
