Officers must have at least a "C" grade point average, be enrolled in an agricultural education course at Bradford High School and be a freshmen, sophomore or junior at the time of application. You will also be required to take a knowledge test over Agricultural Education, FFA, Agriculture and Parliamentary Procedure. Mr. Baumer will provide you with materials to prepare for the test once you submit an application.

You will find in this packet, lots of information and items to complete. Please review it carefully and be sure to meet any deadlines. If you have any questions about any of the items in this packet, please ask Mr. Baumer for clarification.

The date for interviews will be Monday, February 7, 2022. Please ensure you have this date available for interviews. An interview schedule will be available once the application deadline has past. An officer retreat will take place over summer to plan the next school year. If elected to office at the regular February chapter FFA meeting, it is mandatory that you attend the annual chapter FFA banquet which is currently set to take place on Thursday, March 17, 2022 in official dress to be officially installed as a chapter officer.
