Below is a list of possible questions you could be asked during your interview but additional questions beyond this list could be asked:

- 1. Tell me about yourself.
- 2. Why do you feel that you would make a good FFA officer?
- 3. What qualities make you qualified to be an officer?
- 4. What are your strengths?
- 5. What are your weaknesses?
- 6. Tell me about a time you found yourself in a difficult situation. What did you do to get out of it?
- 7. Tell me about at time you worked as part of a team. What did you contribute to the success of the team? What could you have done better?
- 8. What qualities should a member of the FFA officer team possess?
- 9. What activities have you enjoyed most as an FFA member? Why?
- 10. What ideas do you have to recruit more members into FFA?
- 11. If you could be in charge of one activity or event that the FFA does, what would it be and why?
- 12. What activity do you feel needs to be improved within our FFA chapter? What would you do to improve it?
- 13. What ideas do you have to get more members to participate in chapter activities?
- 14. What is one FFA activity that you have not participated in? Why?
- 15. If you were in charge of a tailgate and you ran out of hotdogs, what would you do?
- 16. Who is one of the past FFA officers (any officer) that you look up to? Why?
- 17. Who do you most admire? Why?
- 18. What qualities do you feel you would bring to the officer team?
- 19. How well do you get along with a group of people? (Can you work productively as part of a team?)
- 20. Are you involved with other activities besides FFA? If so, what are they and will they affect the amount of dedication you can give to being a FFA officer?
- 21. If a complete stranger in the community saw you in your FFA jacket and ask you, "What is FFA?" what would you tell them?
- 22. What do you want to be when you grow up and how are Agricultural Education and FFA helping prepare you for that career?
- 23. What is a time that you go outside of your comfort zone? Please explain.
- 24. What is one thing in the FFA that you would tell an incoming freshman that they must do because the end of their freshman year and why?
- 25. What is one thing about FFA that you now know that you wish you would have known when you started your freshman year?
